# Chubby Bear Dolls

#### Random Tips:

Use magic ring as your foundation when starting amigurumi, pull the remaining yarn and tie a knot at the inside to make it strong.

## **Tools and Materials**

- Cotton Yarn (or anything you preferred)
- 3.5mm hook
- 8mm of safety eyes
- 10x8mm of safety nose
- Tapestry Needle
- Scissor
- Glue Gun

### Head: I

Round 1: MR 6 [6]

Round 2 : Inc x 6 [12]

Round 3: (sc, Inc) x 6 [18]

Round 4: (2 sc, Inc) x 6 [24]

Round 5: (3 sc, Inc) x 6 [30]

Round 6: (4 sc, Inc) x 6 [36]

Round 7-11 : sc around [36]

Round 12: (4 sc, dec) x 6 [30]

Round 13: (3 sc, dec) x 6 [24]

#### **Start Stuffing**

Round 14: (2 sc, dec) x 6 [18]

Round 15: (sc, dec) x 6 [12]

Round 16 : Dec x 6 [6]



If you use 3.5mm hook and the right size of yarn, this Chubby Bear's height is going to be 13cm. Slip stitch to next st, fasten off, and leave a long tail to close the head.

### **Body**:

Round 1: MR 6 [6]

Round 2 : Inc x 6 [12]

Round 3: (sc, Inc) x 6 [18]

Round 4: (2 sc, Inc) x 6 [24]

Round 5: Sc around [24]

Round 6: (3 sc, Inc) x 6 [30]

Round 7-9: sc around [30]

Round 10: (3 sc, dec) x 6 [24]

Round 11: Sc around [24]

Round 12: (2 sc, dec) x 6 [18]

Round 13: Sc around [18]

Stuff the body

Slip stitch to next st and leave a long tail to sew.



#### Make two

Round 1: MR 6 [6]

Round 2: Inc x 6 [12]

Round 3: Sc around [12]

Round 4: (3 sc, Inc) x 3 [15]

Don't stuff the ears





#### Slip stitch to next st, fasten off, and leave a long tail.

### Muzzle:

Round 1: MR 6 [6]

Round 2: Inc x 6 [12]

Round 3: Sc around [12]

Stuff the muzzle.

Slip stitch to next st, fasten off, and leave a long tail.



## **Hands**:

#### Make two

Round 1: MR 6 [6]

Round 2: (Sc, Inc) x 3 [9]

Round 3-8: Sc around [9]

Stuff the hands.

Slip stitch to next st, fasten off, and leave a long tail.



## Tail:

Round 1: MR 6 [6]

Round 2: Inc x 6 [12]

Round 3: (2 sc, dec) x 3 [9]

Stuff the tail.



Stuff the bottom part of the legs tightly.

Don't stuff the upper part.

Slip stitch to next st, fasten off, and leave a long tail.

#### Legs:

#### Make two

Round 1: MR 5 [5]

Round 2: Inc x 5 [10]

Round 3: (sc, Inc) x 5 [15]

Round 4-5: Sc around [15]

Round 6: (Sc, dec) x 5 [10]

Round 7-10 : Sc around [10]

Round 11: Dec x 5 [5]

Stuff the legs.

Slip stitch to next st and leave a long tail to close the legs and sew.



# **Attaching Parts and Face:**

I will show you the exact row where I attached the doll's parts. You may change the row to match your style.

• Ears: Row 2-7

• Muzzle: Row 8-12

• Hands: Row 15

• Legs: Row 3-5

• Tail: Row 3-6
